The Terraset PTA is happy to announce a fantastic slate of after-school activities for Terraset students this fall. There are a number of choices, and we think that your child will find something fun and interesting to join. **Lego Club:** The Terraset Lego Club encourages Terraset's future engineers to build models and machines, exercise their spatial abilities, their planning and predictive skills, and develop creative abilities using Lego building bricks. Fun and challenging exercises include free-form creations, collaborative design and construction, and speed build activities. Lego Club will meet Thursdays for 8 weeks, beginning October 8<sup>th</sup>, in the cafeteria, from 3:55-4:45. *Cost for the club is \$25.* Enrollment limited to 40 students, all grades.

**Terraset Nature Club:** The perfect activity for your budding environmentalist, students will participate in raising Brook Trout from eggs in Terraset's new aquarium. Activities will include monitoring trout development and tank water quality, and engaging in stream habitat studies. Nature Club participants will develop an appreciation for water resources and conservation ethics while deepening their understanding of ecosystems. Meetings will include games, crafts and hands-on science. Participants will have the opportunity to record observations and photos of trout development and related learning on the Terraset PTA Clubs Blog to share with friends and family. Club will meet Fridays for 8 weeks, beginning October 9<sup>th</sup>, in the cafeteria, from 3:55-4:45. *Cost for the club is \$25.* Enrollment limited to 15 students, Grades 1-6.

**Ultra Sports/Flag Football:** The guys from Overtime Athletics are back at Terraset with the coolest fall sports for kids! Ultra Sports is their most popular activity for kids in Grades K-2, exposing kids to eight different sports throughout the 8-week session. Coaches introduce the fundamentals, and the kids love to try their skills each week with a different sport! Flag Football is designed to help kids learn teamwork and cooperation, while safely developing better running, catching, agility and focus skills. Overtime Athletics sessions run for 8 weeks, from 3:55-4:55, beginning Tuesday, October 6<sup>th</sup> (Ultra Sports/Grades K-2) and Thursday, October 8<sup>th</sup> (Flag Football/Grades 2-6). *Cost is \$65.* Enrollment limited to 15 students.

**Creative Dance:** Studies show that encouraging children's creative energies enhances their abilities to think and perform. If you have a child whose inner Travolta is just begging to be released, why not try this program, designed specifically for young kids by our very own Liz Falcone. Students will learn dance and movement fundamentals, which promote creative expression and help build self-confidence. Each week, students will be exposed to a variety of dance forms and styles. Grades K-3 will meet on Wednesdays, in the gym, starting October 7<sup>th</sup>, from 3:55-4:55. *Cost is \$55 for 8 sessions.* Class is limited to 15 students.

**Mad Science:** A huge favorite around schools all over the region, the folks at Mad Science are bringing their fantastic inventions back to Terraset. This Fall, kids will hop on board the "ChemWorks" chemistry express for 8 fast-paced experiments. Grades 1-5 will meet in the cafeteria for 8 weeks on Wednesdays, 3:55-4:55, beginning Wednesday, October 14<sup>th</sup>. *Cost is \$80 for 8 sessions,* and includes all supplies. Class is limited to 20 students.
