Volunteer Opportunities *2011-2012*

The **Terraset PTA** is excited to continue its **Three4Me** program. **Three4Me** is a promise, a promise from parent to school and a promise from parent to child. By pledging a promise, parents commit to volunteer three hours of their time to the school throughout the school year. The time can be divided up in as little as 15 minutes each week for a couple of weeks or an hour here and there for various activities.

VOLUNTEER FOR FUNDRAISING!

Read-A-Thon: This very important fundraiser runs throughout the month of October. Students, parents and staff will be encouraged to log their reading for the whole month. Our aim is to read 750,000 minutes. You can help by:

- *assisting with promotions* ▪ *recording logs*

Tigers on the Town: Here is a great chance to show your Tiger Pride and all you need to do is eat your dinner! Just show up at a participating restaurant, which will have offered to donate a portion of their proceeds to Terraset. But first we need volunteers to:

- *assist the coordinator in promoting events* ▪ *make stickers for students to wear home on the day of event*

Box Tops and Campbell's Product Labels: are an easy way to raise money for the school. Collect these items, and have relatives, friends and neighbors collect them too! There will be five collections each year and you could help with:

VOLUNTEER IN OUR COMMUNITY!

PTA Gardens: Thanks to Terraset's beginnings, we have access to a beautiful place on the roof of our school. This unique feature provides an opportunity to share with our children a great resource that highlights the cycles of nature and our role within them. We have a real need to protect this environment. Needed:

- *weed warrior's* ▪ *clean up crew's*

Library Volunteers: Whether you can offer one hour per week, month or semester it would release our librarian to sharing the joys of literature and research with our children. You can help:

- *shelving books* ▪ *assisting with the book fair*

GRACE Arts was developed by the Greater Reston Arts Center to introduce elementary school students to different artists and their styles. This is a volunteer led classroom presentation. Your volunteer commitment would equate to one and a half hours per month and all the lessons are pre-planned for you.

- *some vacancies for docents still exist*

Positive Behavior Intervention Support: The school rewards positive behavior by awarding "Tiger Pride" Slips when students make choices that demonstrate exemplary behavior. This requires a bit of record keeping!
