The Read-A-Thon Rules

- The Read-a-thon will be from **October 1-31, 2011**.
- Younger children may have someone read aloud to them. This time counts as minutes read.
- For students in 2nd through 6th grade, time spent reading a particular book counts only once.
- The total number of minutes read each day should be entered into the weekly reading log.
- Weekly logs should be submitted at school or online at **read.terrasetpta.org**
- Final reading logs are to be submitted by Wednesday Nov. 2nd
- Summary of reading totals will be distributed by Friday Nov. 4th
- Sponsorship sheets and sponsorship money must be returned by Wednesday, Nov. 9th
- Results and Rewards will be announced on Friday, Nov. 11th

Minutes read to young children count toward the child's goal!

What you will do!

1. You will count the minutes you read. This allows people with different reading speeds to challenge each other. It also encourages you to read at, or above, your reading level.
2. You will set a daily "at home" reading goal, we suggest:

| Kindergarten | 20 minutes per day |
| Grades 1-2 | 25 minutes per day |
| Grades 3-6 | 30 minutes per day |
| Adults | 45 minutes per day |
3. We will count both your "at home" and your "at school/work" reading. Teachers will track your school reading. You will log your home reading. We will include both home and school reading in your total minutes for October.
4. You can ask family, friends and neighbors to sponsor you. They might pledge 1c per minute. At the end of the month you will collect your sponsors' pledge, which will be calculated using the total minutes you read. Some people may prefer to give a donation to the Read-a-Thon.
